ATTENTION PARENTS OF CHILDREN WHO WILL BE THREE OR FOUR BY SEPTEMBER 15, 2019

We are now taking names for our 3-Year-Old and 4-Year-Old Preschool Classes. Your child must be three or four by September 15, 2019, to attend.

The 3-Year-Old class is limited to 12 students per class and we will have two classes. One section will meet Monday and Thursday mornings, and the other will meet Tuesday and Friday mornings.

The four-year-old preschool is held four days a week, Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday. The limit is 20 students per class. We have a morning and an afternoon session. Any students that are on our bus routes and plan to ride the bus will attend the morning class, unless you specify differently.

EIGHTH GRADE TRANSITION NIGHT by Angle Bierle




