## FRANCES WREDE GOLL GRAY SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is awarded annually (for no more than four years) to students with an emphasis on veteran status of the applicant or their immediate family. To qualify for the scholarship you or your spouse, parent, grandparent, or sibling must be a current member of the armed forces or a veteran of the armed forces. In addition, please see the following for **Scholarship Eligibility**, **Criteria and Qualifications:** 

- 1. Applicant must be a full-time student at a college, university or trade school. Full-time student shall be defined as a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester.
- 2. An applicant who has completed the freshman (24), sophomore (48), and/or junior (72) years must have earned the minimum semester hours to qualify for a scholarship for the ensuing year. An applicant attending a college using quarter hour system must complete 36 hours to earn each scholarship. Semester hours may include college credit hours earned from college classes student may have successfully completed while also attending high school.
- 3. Proof of enrollment must be submitted to the designated address and/or email address by no later than September 15<sup>th</sup> for verification. If proof of enrollment is not provided by the deadline, no scholarship will be awarded.
- 4. Pursuant to the Last Will and Testament of Frances Wrede Goll Gray, an applicant must have resided within the former Garner-Hayfield Community School District, as defined prior to the 2015-2016 school year, at the time of graduating from the Garner-Hayfield-Ventura Community High School. Applicant must also have graduated from high school within the prior ten years. No open-enrolled applicants are eligible.
- 5. Applicants who are enlisted in the armed services, and actively serving and/or deployed, may request an exception to the full-time student status requirement, number of semester hours completed requirement, proof of enrollment deadline and time-frame for issuance of scholarship funds. The request will be reviewed and voted upon by the Garner-Hayfield-Ventura Education Foundation Board of Directors.

The Garner-Hayfield –Ventura Community School District Education Foundation is the governing body for this scholarship.
