- ii. Paraprofessional Development: Emphasis on tailoring PD to the specific needs of paraprofessionals, with notable contributions from Shawn Miller in PD and Debra Steenhard in Special Education.
- iii. Curriculum Review and Selection: Upcoming team meetings to select materials for piloting new programs, with plans to observe and gather insights from other schools.
- iv. Implementation Timeline: Steps include piloting selected programs and finalizing orders, scheduled for completion between January and March.

b. Middle School:

- i. Renovations and Sports Triumphs: The P8 gym's stunning makeover, led by Kris and his team, coincides with strong winter sports participation – Cheer (14), Wrestling (16), Basketball (27).
- ii. Staff and Student Achievements: Highlights include successful collaborations in Special Ed and school improvement programs, student involvement in jazz band and mock trial, and significant contributions by staff in computer science and the arts.
- iii. Community Engagement and Support: Recognition of the booster club's support for new uniforms, partnership with Mayor Tim Schmidt for student essays, and the hiring of Monkey This! for positive community impact.
- iv. Future Focus and Challenges: Preparations for teacher hiring season, managing substitute teacher shortages, and plans for educational improvements underscore ongoing efforts towards enhancing the school's learning environment.

c. High School:

i. The first semester concluded successfully on December 22nd, with a focus on addressing student learning challenges, particularly for those "at risk" due to various issues including attendance and mental health.

- ii. Professional development emphasized trauma-responsive education and collaborative learning, with special sessions led by Danielle Theis and ongoing work with Tesha Thomas from Solution Tree.
- iii. The school is actively participating in TIC Secondary Principals meetings for collaborative policy and learning development.
- iv. Student activities are in full swing, with sports like wrestling and basketball, and fine arts events like the Dorian Vocal Festival and NIACC Honor Band, alongside efforts to improve sportsmanship.
