We have also completed our Fire and Tornado Drills for the PK-8 building. Fire Safety took place on October 8th. GHV was fortunate to have our local fire department demonstrate fire safety. Our transportation director provided training to students on bus safety and evacuation protocols. The Garner Fire Department completed fire truck tours and obstacle courses for the children in the lunchroom at the PK-8 building.
