- 5. GHV Financing Update Piper/Sandler
  - a. Travis Squires attended the meeting to give the board an overall breakdown of what the last 10 years looked like financially versus what the future financially could hold. Travis reviewed the difference between General Obligation Bond and PPEL additional property taxes.
